1. The Comité was informed that the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002 provided for polling in a public election to be from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. but the States had agreed in 2003 to reduce this to noon to 8 p.m. for elections for Centenier and for Procureur du Bien Public – this change was contained in the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2003. Inadvertently, a new Article 30 (substituted by the Public Elections (Amendment No. 8) (Jersey) Law 2017) had resulted in the 2003 Regulations falling away when the enabling power in the old Article 30 was displaced by the new Article 30.

The Comité considered the shorter polling hours was still appropriate for elections for Centeniers and Procureurs du Bien Public and therefore approved the draft Public Elections (Amendment of Time of Opening of Poll) (Jersey) Regulations 201- and report and requested that they be lodged “au Greffe” for debate by the States on 10th July 2018.

LICAR –
printer for bulk
renewals of
driving licences

1. The Comité considered a letter from the Connétable of St Helier regarding the printing of driving licences. The Connétable explained that there were currently two laser printers for the printing of driving licences, both of which were in daily use, but as yet there was no contingency plan to deal with the additional volumes the bulk renewal would generate from October 2018 and, should one of the current printers malfunction, there would be insufficient capacity to meet the requirements of the twelve parishes. The Parish of St Helier had been informed that a limited number of new laser card personalisation systems (printers) were currently available from stock with a lead in time of about four weeks but, if not in stock, the lead time could extend to several months. Having regard to the urgency to confirm an order to guarantee delivery so as to be able to provide the required service levels for the bulk renewal period for driving licences, the Comité agreed to the purchase of a new printer and that, as with other LICAR expenses, the cost would be shared *pro rata* by parishes.
