1. Since July 2014 to 1/3/2019, how many formal complaints were made to the Constable of St Peter's, in regards to Le Port?

2. Since July 2014 to 1/3/2019, how many formal complaints were made to the police regarding Le Port?

3. Since July 2014 to 1/3/2019, how many formal complaints were made to the honorary police regarding Le Port?

4. From any complaints raised to the constable, police and honorary police, regarding Le Port, in the period from July 2014 to the 1/3/2019, how many resulted in charges being made?

5. From charges being raised, regarding Le Port, in the period July 2014 - 1/3/2019, how many resulted in a conviction?

6. Since 1/8/2018 - 1/3/2019 how many formal complaints were made to the Constable regarding Le Port?

- 7. Since 1/8/2018 1/3/2019 how many formal complaints were made to the police regarding Le Port?
- 8. Since 1/8/2018 1/3/2019 how many formal complaints were made to honorary police?
- 9. Does the SOJ or the Parish of St Peter own all the land at Le Port?
- 10. If so what area?

Response

The number of formal complaints listed in this response relate to a complaint received by way of letter or email. In addition the Constable or honorary police have received complaints by phone call or face to face; whilst these have not been recorded the issues raised have been acted upon where possible.

Formal complaints include those for or against motorhomes/campervans being parked at Le Port, and also complaints about the misuse of the area, rubbish being left and vehicles being abandoned.

Many comments and complaints have also been made through social media and in online responses to media articles but these are not included in this response.

1. Between July 2014 and 1/3/2019, there were 30 formal complaints made to the Constable regarding Le Port.

3. Between July 2014 and 1/3/2019, there were 10 formal complaints made to the Honorary Police regarding Le Port.

6. and 8. Between 1/8/2018 and 1/3/2019, there were 5 formal complaints made to the Constable and 2 formal complaints made to the Honorary Police regarding Le Port. By month the total was 5 in August 2018, and one in each of September and October 2018.

9. The land is owned by States of Jersey.

2, 4, 5, 7 and 10 – this information is not held by the Parish of St Peter. However, a response has been issued by the Government of Jersey <u>Complaints relating to Le Port carpark (FOI)</u> and is available on gov.je.
