Request

I would like to obtain information with regard to the Parish Roads Committee in St Clement and in particular any prior decisions made in respect of the road called Rue des Nouettes, a road that runs down from La Grande Route De St Clement and joins Rue Au Long.

In addition to the above, I cannot find any publicly available information with regard to the roads committee and should be grateful if you are able to provide me with a copy of the minutes of this committee over the past 10 years. A simple copy of one set of minutes would suffice.

Response

1. Rue des Nouettes: copies of the Roads Committee minutes from the two meetings in the last 10 years which mention Rue des Nouettes are as follows:

6 February 2013

Rue des Nouettes

It was noted that the continuous running water along this road was causing serious damage to the surface resulting in endless patching. It was agreed that, in future budgets, provision should be made for the installation of a gully and drain.

6 June 2013

Re-surfacing programme 2013 – 2014

The Connétable advised that whilst the budget was not yet finalised it was likely that the usual budget of £25,000 would be set aside for major re-surfacing works.

The Committee agreed to progress with the re-surfacing work at the northern end of Rue de Causie (approximately £8,500) and to install a surface water drain in Rue de Nouettes (approx. £9,000).

It was also noted that there were several areas in need of patching which would be addressed in due course.

3. Roads Committee Minutes: these are not currently published as they are not Data Protection compliant, however we intend to rectify this when time allows.

Exemption:

Information is absolutely exempt information if – (a) it constitutes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject as defined in the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018; and (b) its supply to a member of the public would contravene any of the data protection principles, as defined in that Law.
