## Request:

Please supply the following information to me by e-mail in respect of the proposal by the Parish of St Helier to scrap the current Parish Assembly system in favour of a new St Helier Council:

- (1) Any correspondence, whether by e-mail or letter, during 2018 that passed between the Constable of St Helier or the Chief Executive Officer of the Parish of St Helier, on one hand, and any Minister of the States of Jersey or the Chief Executive Officer of the States of Jersey on the other, where the subject was the proposed formation of a new St Helier Council;
- (2) Any internal reports or briefings produced by or on behalf of the Parish of St Helier or the St Helier Roads Committee during 2018 where the subject of these reports or briefings was the proposed formation of a St Helier Council.
