## **Non-exempt (public) under Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011**

The Supervisory Committee confirmed that the Connétable of St Peter should preside at the meeting.

- Minutes 1. The minutes of the meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2016, having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.
- Annual Island Wide Rates Figure for 2016 2. The Supervisory Committee noted that the Annual Island Wide Rates Figure for 2015 was £11,910,062 and that Article 20 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 provided for this to be increased by RPI to determine the figure for 2016. The RPI for the 12 months to March 2016 was 1.4% thus the AIRF for 2016 was £12,076,803 (this had been confirmed by the Director of Accounting Services, Treasury and Resources Department, States of Jersey). In accordance with the Rates (Apportionment) (Jersey) Regulations 2006 -
- (1) 55% of the Annual Island-wide Rates Figure shall be met from the domestic rate (£6,642,242).
- (2) 45% of the Annual Island-wide Rates Figure shall be met from the non-domestic rate (£5,434,561).
- The Domestic and Non-domestic rates would be determined when all parishes had completed the assessments for 2016.
- Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 – RMS e-parishes enhancements 3. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 2 of 18<sup>th</sup> April 2016, noted feedback received on the e-parishes enhancement to enable ratepayers to access Notices of Assessment online.
