| Minutes  | 1. The minutes of the meeting held on 12 <sup>th</sup> December 2016, having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.  |

The Supervisory Committee noted the 2017 Actuaries certificate which confirmed the monthly contributions payable from January 2017 for membership in PECRS/PEPS and that the monthly contribution to meet the Employer's share of the pre-1987 debt under the 1967 scheme would be £76.   |

The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 3 of 23 <sup>rd</sup> May 2016, noted feedback from ratepayers who had used the online service to make the 2017 Annual Return and agreed that, if specific to a Parish, the Connétable should have the opportunity to reply to the ratepayer. The Committee, pursuant to Articles 3, 8 and 25 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005, confirmed the paper and digital formats to be used depending upon the method of communication selected by a ratepayer for annual return, notice of assessment and rate demand correspondence, including reminders. The Committee further confirmed the proposals for the digital format of annual return information relating to significant property portfolios. |
| Draft Finance<br>(2017 Budget)<br>(Jersey) Law<br>201-<br>(P.113/2016) | 4. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 2 of 12 <sup>th</sup> December 2017, noted the States decision on the Draft Finance (2017 Budget) (Jersey) Law 201- (P.113/2016):<br><br>1. Not to remove the current exemptions from rates for public and parochial authorities; and   |

2. To amend the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 to provide for Regulations which may be made by the States for the revaluation of land, in particular –
  - (a) make provision for a method by which revaluation of land is to be carried out; and
  - (b) apply any provision of this Law in its application to such land in a manner modified by the Regulations.

The Committee noted that the Minister for Treasury and Resources proposed that the Deputy Director – Tax Policy, the Director – Corporate Policy should meet with the Secretary to discuss the scope and how the process might work, together with a draft timetable for 2017.
