Non-exempt (public) under Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011

- Minutes 1. The minutes of the meeting held on 11th December 2017, having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.
- Association of Jersey Rates Assessors – AGM and rating of moveable horse shelters 2. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute nos. 3 and 4 of 11th December 2017, noted a reply from the Chairman of the Association of Jersey Rates Assessors regarding meetings of the Chairmen of the parochial Assessment Committees (to ensure that there was a commonality of approach and that there was uniformity in rateable values throughout Jersey) and the rating of moveable horse shelters.
- PECRS/PEPS 3. The Supervisory Committee noted the 2018 Actuaries certificate which confirmed the monthly contributions payable from January 2018 for membership in PECRS/PEPS and that the monthly contribution to meet the Employer’s share of the pre-1987 debt under the 1967 scheme would be £80.
- Rates online 4. The Supervisory Committee noted that, in response to a ratepayer comment about difficulty using the online Annual Return service, an investigation had shown that the information contained in the ratepayer’s email correspondence appeared to be using Advanced Threat Protection (ATP) feature. This feature of Microsoft Outlook replaced all links in incoming emails from outside servers and was intended to provide email recipients with protection against threats that might be triggered by clicking email links.

Teleologica Ltd was investigating how to address this emerging issue so as to avoid any service disruption for ratepayers.
