1. The minutes of the meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> September 2017, having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.

2. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 6 of 18<sup>th</sup> September 2017, noted that the Minister for Treasury and Resources, in the Draft Budget Statement 2018 (P.90/2017) had reported that, "*in consulting stakeholders over the payment of rates by the States, it has been made clear that 11 of the 12 Connétables, who are the guardians of the parish rate system, do not support either the principle of the States paying rates or the specific proposal put to them. In light of this, I am not bringing forward measures in this budget.*".

The Committee was informed by the Connétable of St Helier that he intended to lodge an amendment which, if approved, would require the States to pay parish rates and agreed that, when the terms of such an amendment were known, it would consider presenting its comments thereon to the States.
