| Minutes   | 1. The minutes of the meeting held on 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2019, having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.   |
| Rate Appeal Board – report for 2019                 | 2. The Supervisory Committee noted a report from the Rate Appeal Board advising that there had been no appeals in 2019 and requested that this be forwarded to the Association of Jersey Rates Assessors for information.   |
| Rates Working Group                                 | 3. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 4 of 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2019, noted that the Rates Working Group (RWG) report was expected to be available for the next meeting.  |
| Island-wide rate – consultation on re-apportionment | 4. The Supervisory Committee, with partial reference to its minute no. 4 of 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2019, gave further consideration to the consultation on the apportionment of the Island-wide rate in accordance with Article 20 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005. The Committee agreed that the Connétables of St Helier and St John should lead the consultation; the Connétables would therefore liaise with the Chief Minister and with the rate payers or groups or bodies representing rate payers it had contacted and would consider the form of public consultation to be undertaken. |
| Office – accounts 2018/19                           | 5. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 3 of 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2019, received the audited accounts for the Comité des Connétables/Supervisory Committee for the year ended 30 <sup>th</sup> April 2019 and noted expenditure of £86,079 and income of £87,205 thus resulting in a surplus of £1,126 for the year. The balance sheet, which included the Comité des Chefs de Police, showed net current assets of £22,828. The auditors Alex Picot  |
