6. Who has made requests, and who has turned down requests from CCTV at St John's Rec skatepark?
7. Where can we see a copy of the licence agreement between St John Skating Association and St John's Recreational Board? Who signed this?
8. What are the St John's Recreational Board's specific concerns around additional Insurance and Safeguarding, pertaining to the skateboard facility?
9. VERY IMPORTANT Where can we see the current business plan for SJRB (in the previous FOI "SJRG" is referred to – assuming this is a typo and SJRB is meant).

Response

1. The St John's Recreation Ground (Centre) is owned by the Billy Butlin Memorial Trust.
2. This information is exempt.

Article 23 - Information accessible to applicant by other means

Information is absolutely exempt information if it is reasonably available to the applicant, otherwise than under this Law, whether or not free of charge. A scheduled public authority that refuses an application for information on this ground must make reasonable efforts to inform the applicant where the applicant may obtain the information.

Justification for exemption

St John Centre Limited is another name of St John Centre Trust which is a registered Jersey Charity no. 419, registered with the Jersey Charity Commissioner and the information is available on Public Register Charities Register (charitycommissioner.je).

The information has been published in response to a FOI request (available [here](#)) which stated that Andrew Jehan attended as a Director of St John Centre Limited and a Trustee of the St John Centre Trust in his own name and not in his capacity as Connétable of St John.
