Request

In July 2020 the States approved the creation of Designated Roads, on which pedestrians, cyclists & horse riders would have priority and which would have a maximum 20 mph speed limit.

Since then can each parish confirm the number and names of parish roads which:

- 1) Have been so designated
- 2) Roads where the speed limit has been reduced to 20mph maximum
- 3) Additional Green Lanes

Response

No roads have been designated.

The proposition “Green Lanes And Quiet Lanes: Priority To Pedestrians, Cyclists And Horse Riders” (P.79/2020 [Propositions \(gov.je\)](#)) was adopted by the States. This requires changes to legislation to give effect to priority being given in law to pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders and that vehicular traffic should only be allowed in such designated roads for essential travel. Amendments to the legislation have not yet been agreed and so no roads have been designated in this way.
