



RATES (JERSEY) LAW 2005

Notification of representative of joint ratepayers of property

- Where two or more people are liable to pay a rate in respect of land, Article 30 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 provides that they may at any time give the Connétable written notice of the name of which of them is to be first entered in the Rates List as representing all of them. The person so named is a member of the Parish Assembly and is entitled to represent all the persons who are liable to pay any rate levied in respect of that land in all matters in which a ratepayer is entitled to representation by virtue of the above law.
- Other joint owners may also be a member of the Parish Assembly if their names are on the Electoral Register of the Parish (please ask for further details or refer to your Parish website).
- In the case of the Parish of St Helier it also makes the person nominated eligible for parochial office in the Parish even though he does not live in that Parish.
- If you are jointly liable to pay rates in a Parish and you wish to change the name of the person first entered in the Rates List in respect of that property please fill out this form and return it to the Connétable of the Parish in which you pay rates as soon as possible (you must complete a separate form in respect of each Parish). Notice given after approval of the Rates List for the year will be of no effect until the next rateable year starts (1 January).
- *Notes - A member of the Parish Assembly has ONE vote on any decision by the Assembly.*

These serve to protect your information in accordance with the DPJL and set out what a third party may do with your personal data including to prevent and detect crime, for law enforcement or to protect individuals from harm or injury. We may send your personal details (including your name, address and amount due) to a debt collection agency where you have rates outstanding. The approved Rates List for the year contains each property address and rateable value and is, by law, available for inspection by the public at the Parish Hall and at Jersey Library.</p>	<p>Your rights: You can ask us for a copy of the information we hold about you and to correct or update this. You can ask us to stop or restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.
