2020 Island Wide Rate draft COVID-19 (Rates) (Jersey) Regulations 202- P.85/2020 1. The Supervisory Committee, with reference to its minute no. 3 of 22nd June 2020, noted that the Minister for Treasury and Resources had lodged "au Greffe" for debate on 14th July 2020 the draft COVID-19 (Rates) (Jersey) Regulations 202- (P.85/2020).

The Committee was unanimous in supporting the proposition as, if approved by the States, it would retain the Annual Island-wide Rate Figure (AIRF) at the 2019 sum rather than it be adjusted in accordance with Article 20(1) of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005. The domestic and non-domestic rates would then be set based on the 2019 AIRF and, as the assessment of rateable values in 2020 had not significantly increased, this would avoid an increase in the domestic and non-domestic rates of at least 2.7%.

The Committee approved comments on P.85/2020 and requested that the Comité des Connétables present them to the States.

Following the States decision on P.85/2020, the Committee agreed it would determine the 2020 Island-wide rate for domestic and for non-domestic ratepayers.
