Request

I should be grateful if you could provide the number of property owners / occupiers, if any, who received infraction notices / fines / prosecution under the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie As Amended, on Highview Lane, St Helier (Mont-a-l'Abbé) for the years 2019 to date. Please could you provide the information by year, and by month, categorised as to whether it is an infraction notice, a fine, or a prosecution.

Response

Fewer than five property owners/occupiers have received infraction notices / fines / prosecution in 2023 under the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie as amended in relation to Highview Lane, St Helier (Mont-a-l'Abbé).

No notices / fines / prosecution were issued for the years 2019 to 2022 inclusive.

The Parish holds the information broken down by month and type (infraction notices / fines / prosecution) but given the low number of cases involved, disclosure of this level of detail could lead to the identification of the individuals involved when combined with other information that may be already in the public domain or known to others. Article 25 of the Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011 has been applied to protect the personal information of the individuals concerned.

FOI exemptions applied:

Article 25(2) - Personal Information

Information is absolutely exempt information if – (a) it constitutes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject as defined in the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018; and (b) its supply to a member of the public would contravene any of the data protection principles, as defined in that Law.
