Request

I should be grateful if you could provide the number of property owners / occupiers, if any, who received infraction notices / fines / prosecution under the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie As Amended, on Rue Becq, Trinity, and Rue des lfs, Trinity, for the years 2019 to date.

Please could you provide the information for each road separately, and by year, and by month, categorised as to whether it is an infraction notice, a fine, or a prosecution.

Response

The number of owners/occupiers who have received infraction notices/fines/prosecutions each year from 2019-2023 under the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie, as amended in relation to La Rue Becq and Rue des lfs, Trinity is:

2019 - No notices /fines/prosecutions were issued in the year

2020 - No notices /fines/prosecutions were issued in the year

2021 - No notices /fines/prosecutions were issued in the year

2022 - Fewer than five notices/fines/prosecutions were issued in the year

2023 - Fewer than five notices/fines/prosecutions have been issued in the year to date.

The Parish holds information broken down by month and type (infraction notices/fines/prosecutions) but, given the low number involved, disclosure of this level of detail could lead to the identification of individuals involved when combined with other information that may already be in the public domain or known to others. Article 25 of the Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011 has been applied to protect the personal information of any individuals concerned.

FOI exemptions applied:

Article 25(2) - Personal Information

Information is absolutely exempt information if – (a) it constitutes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject as defined in the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018; and (b) its supply to a member of the public would contravene any of the data protection principles, as defined in that Law.
