Request

1. What is the total number of notices issued by the Parish of St Peter alleging parking infractions within the confines of the Airport as defined in the Aerodromes (Jersey) Regulations 1965 during the years 2021, 2022, and 2023?
2. Were all of these notices issued by the Parish of St Peter under powers delegated to the Parish of St Peter by the Airport Director?
3. What was the total revenue received in respect of these notices?
4. Was the revenue retained by the Parish of St Peter, remitted to the Airport Director, or shared? If shared what was the sharing arrangement?
5. When were cameras installed at the Airport to collect evidence in support of alleged offences?

Response

1. to 4.

The Parish of St Peter does not issue parking infraction notices within the confines of Jersey Airport; these are issued by the Airport Director pursuant to the [Aerodromes \(Jersey\) Regulations 1965 \(jerseylaw.je\)](http://jerseylaw.je). Parking infractions are referred to the Parish of St Peter for collection of the penalty.

A person who contravenes any direction issued by the airport authority is liable to a fine of level 2 on the standard scale. The [Aerodromes \(Administration\) \(Jersey\) Law 1952 \(jerseylaw.je\)](http://jerseylaw.je) provides at Article 5 that where a person is charged with any offence under Regulations, i.e. the Aerodromes (Jersey) Regulations 1965, and accepts the decision of a Centenier having jurisdiction in the matter, that Centenier may inflict and levy summarily a fine of level 1 on the standard scale. Article 6 provides that where such a fine is imposed, one half of that fine shall be awarded for the benefit of the parish in which the offence was committed and the other half shall be awarded for the benefit of the annual income of the States and applied towards the cost of regulating the parking and circulating of vehicles within the territorial limits of any aerodrome.
