### Request

Can I please have a copy of the Requête, c. 1997, relating to the employment of the Parish Secretary and any relevant minutes or correspondence.

Also, any information in relation to the outcome of a complaint to the Law Officers by Deputy Hacquoil, a signatory to the Requête, about a penalty under the Branchage provisions.

#### Response

Requête c. 1997 – the information is exempt under Article 23.

Complaint to the Law Officers by Deputy Hacquoil – the information is not held.

#### FOI exemptions applied:

# Article 23 - Information accessible to applicant by other means

Information is absolutely exempt information if it is reasonably available to the applicant, otherwise than under this Law, whether or not free of charge. A scheduled public authority that refuses an application for information on this ground must make reasonable efforts to inform the applicant where the applicant may obtain the information.
