The information sought from each Parish is:

- How many names were removed from the Parish's electoral roll in 2024 (under Article 8 of the Elections (Jersey) Law 2002)?

Response

Names are removed from the Parishes' electoral registers in accordance with Article 8 of the Elections (Jersey) Law 2002 see: Article 8: https://www.jerseylaw.je/laws/current/l_12_2002#_Toc181812193 for the following reasons:

- 1) The person is no longer eligible as an elector in that Parish eg moved address within Jersey;
- 2) The person is deceased; or
- 3) The person is no longer resident in Jersey.

A total of 8,638 individuals were removed from the Parishes electoral rolls in 2024 and the breakdown is:
