Request

Please could I request under the Freedom of Information Law the number of Data Breaches that have been logged in the past 3 years with the Parish of St Helier and dates these were logged.

Please could I also request the expenditure of the Parish of St Helier for their contract with Law at Work for 2023, 2024 & 2025.

Response

As per Article 20 of the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018 the Parish of St Helier has reported less than 5 incidents of data breaches each year to the Jersey Office of the Information Commissioner (JOIC) for 2023, 2024 and 2025. (Note 1)

The information held regarding the Parish of St Helier's expenditure with Law at Work is as follows:

£46,921.48 from May 2022 to April 2023

£42,445.50 from May 2023 to April 2024

£95,603.55 from May 2024 to April 2025 (Note 2)

£69,872.46 from May 2025 to March 2026 (Note 2)

Notes:

1. Due to the low number of cases, a disclosure control has been applied to protect the privacy of individuals when figures are below five.
2. There was an increase in 2025 as the Parish of St Helier commissioned Law at Work to conduct a Health and Safety review, produce an action plan and follow through.
