Request

Could I request and FOI to capture the number of times a speed check has occurred (by both the Police and Honorary Police on 1) Peirson Road in St Helier, and 2) Lewis St in St Helier, since 2021.

Response

1. Pierson Road – 22 speed checks by the Honorary Police since 2021.
2. Lewis Street – no speed checks by the Honorary Police but a speed identification device (SID) was installed in Lewis Street in March 2021.

The Parish does not hold details of speed checks by the States of Jersey Police, therefore, Article 10 of the Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011 applies, however, it may be held by the Government of Jersey so you might wish to send your information request in writing to:

Article 10 - Obligation of scheduled public authority to confirm or deny holding information

- (1) Subject to paragraph (2), if –
- (a) a person makes a request for information to a scheduled public authority; and
 - (b) the authority does not hold the information, it must inform the applicant accordingly
