Cleaning of pavements in St Helier:

- 1) How often are the pavements cleaned (swept & cleaned of rubbish)?
- 2) How often are the pavements washed?
- 3) Has the frequency of either 1) or 2) changed over the last 15 years?

Response

- 1) Pavements within the Town Centre and Ring Road areas are cleaned daily, either manually or mechanically. In exceptional circumstances, such as staff sickness, resources may be adjusted; however, a vehicle will still patrol the route to ensure litter bins are emptied and any visible debris is cleared.
- 2) Pavements are washed on average once per year. Some higher-footfall areas and key thoroughfares may be washed more frequently where operationally required.
- 3) The frequency of responses 1) and 2) has changed over the last 15 years. Street cleansing operations have been improved through the introduction of pre-determined cleansing routes, providing greater consistency and making it easier to identify and address any roads or pavements that may have been missed.
